Treasurer's Report: Karen gave Carolyn Patton's report indicating a bank balance of \$11,711.13. After deducting \$2,457 for the scholarship and educational funds, the balance is \$9,253.94.

Exhibits: Karen stated we are looking for a new Exhibit Chair. However, several Exhibits have already been planned. An Exhibit is arranged at the Parman Branch Library, 20735 Wilderness Oak, SA TX, 78258 for February 2019.
